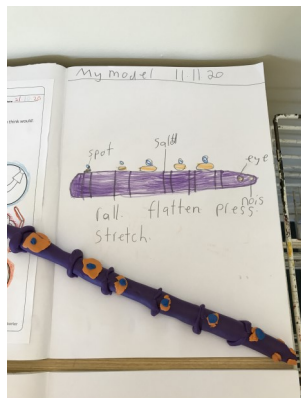
They talked to students and had a video presentation for them to watch. Their big message from everyone is:-
