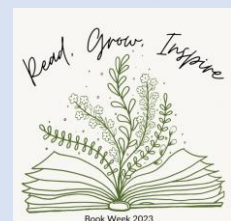
Families are invited to join us for the parade next Friday which will take place between 10:30 am – 11:30 am with light refreshments and tea and coffee afterwards.

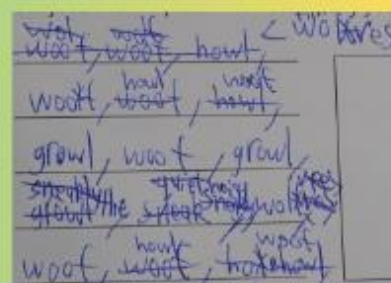
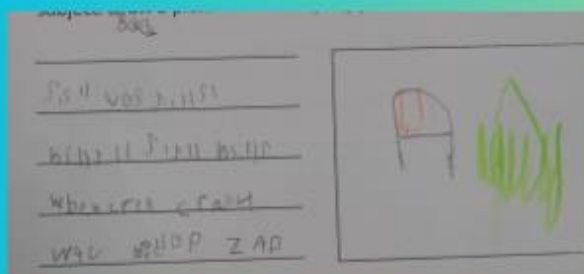
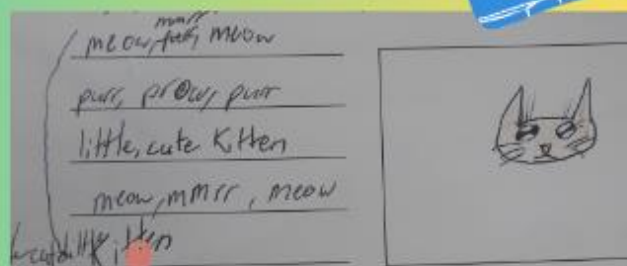
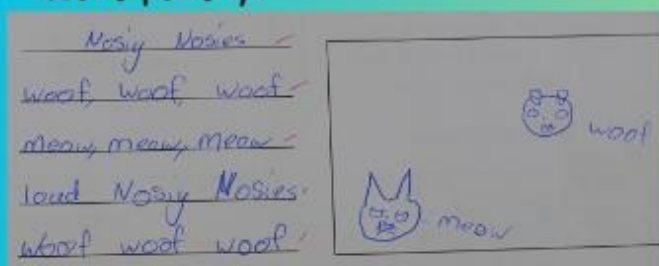
Subject: Poetry

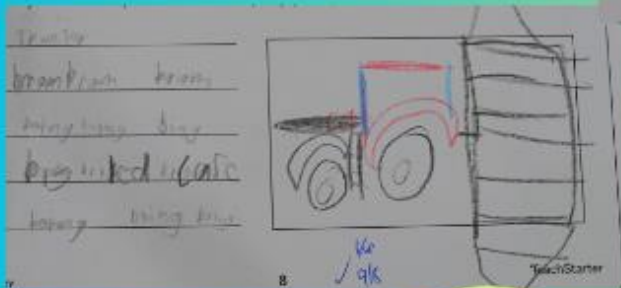
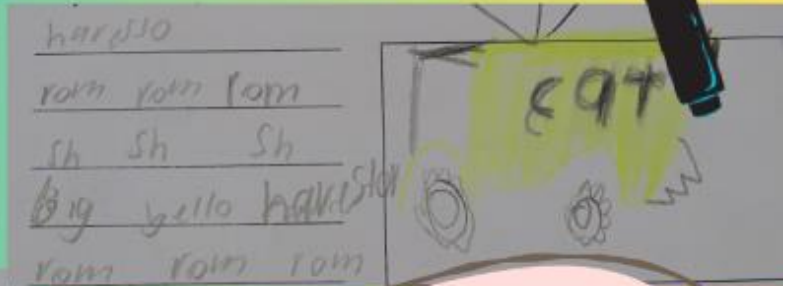
Take a look at their poems they have written and their feedback about poetry.
