MATHS POSITION

4 X 4 GRID

In math last week, we constructed a 4 x 4 grid with start in the top left corner and finish in the bottom right corner.



DIRECTIONS

Each student had to use positional language to describe how to get from the start of the grid to the finish of the grid. Students then directed each other through the grid using positional language.



To make the task more complex, we added some obstacles for students to navigate.



MATHS OVERVIEW

Math lessons begin with a number focus for the first twenty minutes each day. From Monday to Wednesday, number is a small group focused lesson with two teachers available to students. For the remainder of the lesson, the whole class work on a specific focus such as statistics and probability, and working mathematically through communication reasoning, fluency and problem solving.
