Subject: Math

Math sessions in the primary class have taken a big focus on time.

Students have been learning how to read time, convert 12-hour time to 24-hour time and how to interpret timetables.

Learning to tell the time is a valuable life skill. It can help you determine whether you're running late or whether you have plenty of time to spare. It can also help you catch a train, bus, or plane on time, and allows you to know if you're going to make it to an important get-together early or late.

Being able to tell the time is a strength that promotes self esteem and confidence.

At home you can help your children practise by asking what time it is on a clock and having your child set the clock to a time you give them.

I would encourage you to consider putting a clock in the bedroom and make sure it's analogue, so they have to start reading a proper clock face.

It's even possible to get a colour-coded clock that distinguishes between different sides, to really help with their time-learning experience.
