Students in the primary classroom took part in our annual CPR training day on 22nd May.





Reconciliation at DPS



Now More Than Ever



Chicken & Veggie Soup



Ingredients

- 2 tbsp olive oil
- 1 onion, diced
- 1 clove garlic, crushed
- 2 sticks celery, diced
- 2 carrots, peeled and diced
- 2 zucchini, diced
- 5 ½ cups dry soup mix (a mix of peas, barley and lentils), rinsed
- 2 l chicken stock (salt-reduced)
- 600 g skinless chicken breast, chopped into bite sized pieces
- 2 cups water

Good for kids
good for life



Method

- 1 Heat the oil in a large soup saucepan on a medium heat.
- 2 Add onion and garlic and cook until soft.
- 3 Add the veggies and stir through.
- 4 Add the soup mix, stock, chicken and water and bring to the boil, skimming off any foam that rises to the surface.
Reduce heat to low and cook for 1 hour, stirring occasionally.
- 5 Season with pepper and serve.
